

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

While older lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender (LGBT) adults confront many of the same issues when it comes to aging, the reality for LGBT people can be drastically different from their non-LGBT peers. "Rolling Out a Rainbow Welcome" provides an overview of the unique needs and experiences of LGBT older adults so that service providers, advocates, and the aging network can consider these factors when serving this population. LGBT older



adults have experienced lifetimes of discrimination and mistreatment, contributing to an array of social, financial, emotional, and physical health needs. LGBT seniors aging without familial support networks are more likely to have to rely on the aging network for care, yet too often these systems of care are unprepared to serve the unique and complex needs of LGBT older adults. In this session conference participants will learn how to address the disparities through best practices that are grounded in cultural awareness, humility, and responsiveness.


